The successful candidate will work under the direction of Dr. Amer Burhan in the role of "Clinical Research Assistant". This position will assist Dr. Burhan to secure and administer industry, peer-sponsored, and local investigator/sponsored clinical research trials. There is a broad range of responsibilities, with a focus on all dimensions of Clinical Trials Administration and Initiation. This includes day-to-day operations of clinical studies including:

- Training on and conducting standardized clinical and cognitive assessments
- Consenting participants
- Maintain records and databases
- Facilitate recruitment
- Help in preparation and set up of ethics submissions and preparation of manuscripts and other publications
- Participate in study promotional activities as per ethics approval
- Liaison with clinics, patients, physicians and healthcare workers
- Management of clinical trial documentation assuring investigational product accountability and reconciliation
- Manage adverse events and assures adherence to reporting requirements for serious events
